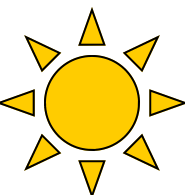
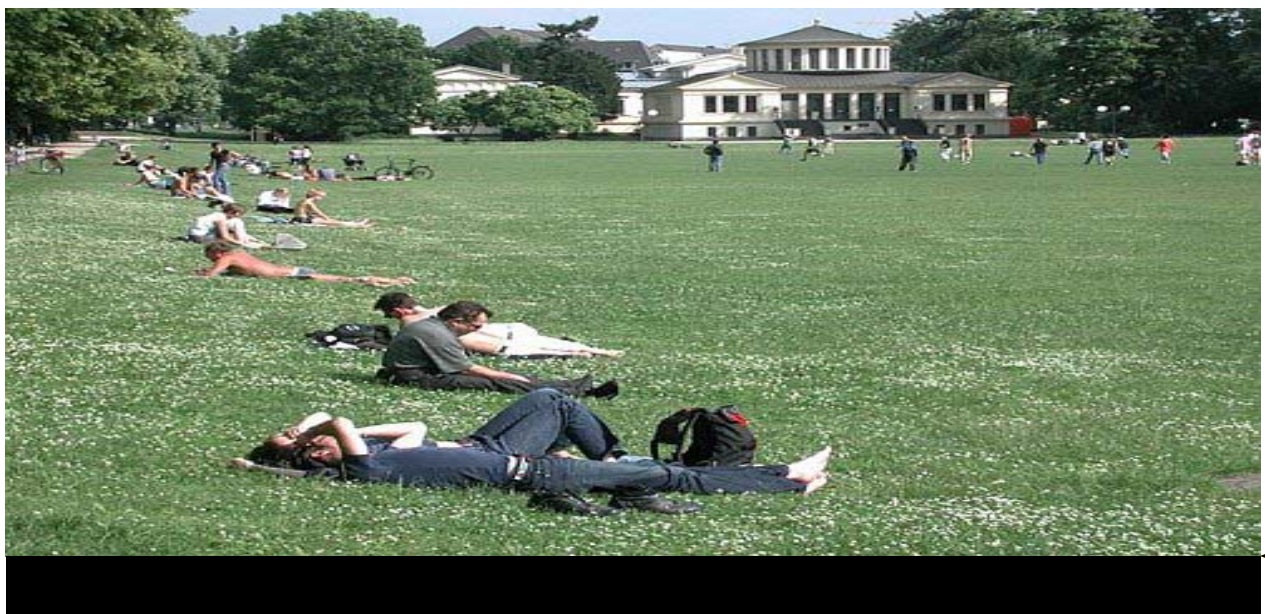
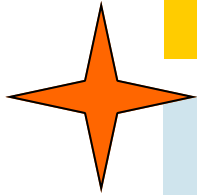


Study in Germany

Those who study in Germany or would like to go abroad or who study outside Germany and feel attracted by Germany will keep on coming across DAAD – “Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst” or German Academic Exchange Service in English. Much of the advice on and arrangement of study support in the field of educational and academic exchange between Germany and countries around the world is managed by DAAD. In its capacity as a joint institution of Germany’s higher education community, DAAD is responsible for promoting international academic cooperation, particularly by arranging the worldwide exchange of students, graduates, university lecturers and professors.

An important goal for DAAD is to maintain and to raise the appeal of Germany as a base for scientific and academic activity. Besides the general objective of promoting international understanding, motivation involves advancing the spread of the German language (as a cultural motive), establishing international solidarity, pursuing economic interests and furthering international co-operation in higher education and academic exchange by providing information on German higher education.
